Required Reasonable Suspicion (Drug/Alcohol)
Training for Supervisors

December 2, 2021 - 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM,
Virtual Session

This training is designed for supervisors or other company officials authorized to make reasonable suspicion determinations. The first hour will cover the signs and symptoms of probable drug use and the next hour will cover probable alcohol misuse. Physical, behavioral, speech and performance indicators are also included. Upon completion, participants will receive a certificate indicating they have satisfied the DOT agency requirements for supervisor training.

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and the GABOE, any administrator/designee who supervises bus drivers (or the loading or unloading of students from buses) must attend this two-hour training. The training will be used by the administrator to determine whether reasonable suspicion exists to require a driver to undergo testing under Section 382.307. It is recommended that two people are trained at each school site.
